## The Liturgy of the Palms

**Prelude:** Jamie Meyerholz (piano)

*Celebrant* Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord.

*People* **Peace in heaven and glory in the highest.**

*Celebrant* Let us pray.

**The Gospel Reading:** *Luke 19: 29-40*

*Reader* The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Mark.

*People* **Glory to you Lord Christ.**

As he approached Bethphage and Bethany at the hill called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples, saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' say, 'The Lord needs it.'" Those who were sent ahead went and found it just as he had told them. <sup>33</sup> As they were untying the colt, its owners asked them, "Why are you untying the colt?" They replied, "The Lord needs it." They brought it to Jesus, threw their cloaks on the colt and put Jesus on it. As he went along, people spread their cloaks on the road. When he came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of disciples began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen: "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples!" "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out."

### An Introduction of the Crowd

*Celebrant* The Lord be with you.

*Crowd* **And also with you.**

*Celebrant* Let us pray

We praise you, Almighty God, for the acts of love by which you have redeemed us through your Son Jesus

Christ our Lord. On this day, he entered the holy city of Jerusalem in triumph, and was proclaimed as King of kings by those who spread their garments and branches of palm along his way. Let these branches be for us signs of his victory, and grant that we who bear them in his name may ever hail him as our King, and follow him in the way that leads to eternal life; who lives and reigns in glory with you and the Holy Spirit, now and for ever. Amen.

*Celebrant* Then Jesus entered into Jerusalem, with the people going before and behind him singing his praises, "Hosannah! Hosannah in the Highest" and Jesus went into the temple.  
Let us go forth in the name of Christ!

*Crowd* Hosannah! Hosannah in the Highest!
