## SERMON SERIES: THE BOOK OF ACTS

*Unstoppable: A Study of the Book of Acts* (begins 01/11) to begin this church's 50<sup>th</sup> year of ministry, we will grow our faiths and increase our confidence in the church's mission to be the light of the world by seeing just how unstoppable Jesus' message of God's love has proven to be from the beginning – even against the most radical of obstacles.

## SUNDAY MORNING CLASSES

### Adults

*"Rediscover Jesus" by Matthew Kelly*

Through reflection and conversation, we'll explore honest questions, spiritual renewal, and how faith shapes the way we live and love.

*Examining the Creeds*

An exploration of the Apostles' Creed and the Nicene Creed, considering their origins, meaning, and enduring place in the life and worship of the Church.

*2026 Foundations of our Faith*

For both new and long-term members, this four-week Christianity 101 style course is designed to enrich your understanding of our church, our worship, and our ministries. This class also prepares anyone who wishes to officially join or be received into this church by our bishop this winter.

**Youth:** *Rooted in Christ: Stories of Belonging, Growth, and Grace*

A six-week Sunday School series centered in Scripture and the life of Jesus. Together we'll explore what it means to be rooted in Christ, how faith grows through community, and how God meets us with grace in every season of life.

**Children:** *Seeking Justice Together*

In this class, we'll explore Jesus' call to care for the vulnerable and to set things right. Through stories, discussion, and interactive activities.

**Children's Chapel:** *Mini-Revolutions*

(during 10:30 Worship every Sunday) A story time followed by interactive learning stations that use art, movement, prayer and play to explore the meaning of that day's Bible verse from the lectionary.

## WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

### Adults

*Diving Deeper – Acts of the Apostles*: A complement to the sermon series, this class offers a closer group exploration of the week's selection.

*The Chosen Season Four*: A relaxing, meaningful viewing and discussion of season four of the Chosen. This series helps to bring alive the character of God we meet in the man Jesus.

**Youth: Grades 6-12**

*Rooted: Building Community That Lasts*

We'll explore what it means to be part of a community where you're known, supported, and reminded that you belong – just as you are.

**KidsClub: Grades K-5**

Learn how to pray the Anglican Rosary through simple songs and gentle repetition. Each child will make their very own rosary to take home for Lent.
