## SUNDAY MORNING CLASSES

### ADULTS

**Grateful** - Join Josh Morton for a Sunday School series inspired by *Grateful* by Diana Butler Bass. Through film and discussion, we'll explore how gratitude can shape our spiritual lives. Together, we'll consider how it leads us into deeper generosity, healing, and hope.
